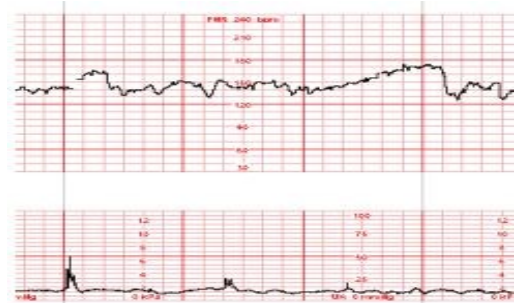




## EFM Certification Preparation Course Presented by Carol Burke

Uteroplacental physiology, pattern recognition and intrauterine resuscitation interventions are central to knowledge and use of this technology.
